Secretary Gray Condemns Maine Secretary of State's Decision to Remove Donald Trump from Ballot, Calls it Election Interference

CHEYENNE, WY – In response to Maine Secretary of State Shenna Bellows' decision to bar Donald Trump from appearing on Maine's presidential primary ballot for the 2024 Election, Wyoming Secretary of State Chuck Gray responded with outraged condemnation.

"I am appalled by these outrageous, unAmerican attempts to remove Donald Trump from the ballot," Secretary Gray said in a statement. "Not only have we seen these attempts by the judicial system in Colorado, which I fought back against, but we are now seeing these outrageously wrong decisions come straight from elections administrators, like Secretary Bellows.
