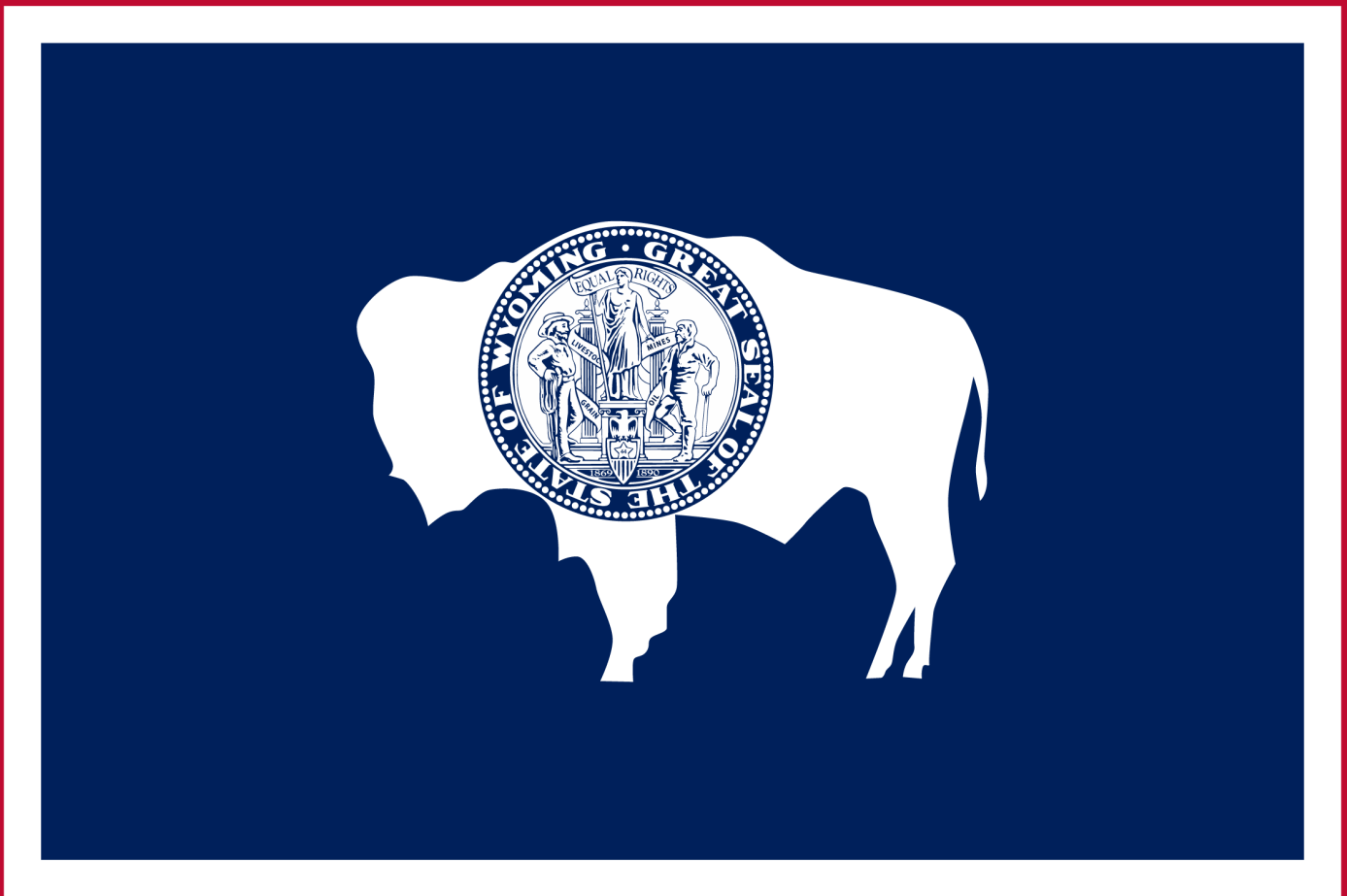

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GENERAL VOTING INFORMATION

VOTING IN-PERSON – VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

Voters are required to show an acceptable form of identification when voting in person. Any of the following will be accepted:

- WY Driver's License or ID Card
- Tribal ID Card
- Valid U.S. Passport
- U.S. Military Card
- Driver's License or ID Card from Another State
- University of Wyoming Student Photo ID
- Wyoming Community College Student Photo ID
- Wyoming Public School Student Photo ID
- Valid Medicare or Medicaid Insurance Card
- Valid Wyoming Concealed Firearm Permit

VOTING ABSENTEE

If you are a registered voter, you may request an absentee ballot at any time during the calendar year in which the election is held but *not* on the day of the election. Absentee voting begins, and ballots are distributed, 28 days before the election.

To request an absentee ballot, contact your County Clerk. You will need to provide your full name, residence address, mailing address, and date of birth. Remember to ensure that your absentee ballot is returned to your County Clerk's office by 7 p.m. on Election Day.

Military & Overseas Citizen Voting (UOCAVA)

If you are an active duty member of the Armed Forces, Merchant Marine, Public Health Service, or NOAA Commissioned Corps, an eligible family member of covered military personnel, or a U.S. citizen residing outside the United States, you may be eligible to vote under the Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act (UOCAVA). UOCAVA voting begins, and ballots are distributed, 45 days before the election. To request a UOCAVA ballot, contact your County Clerk by phone, mail, email, or in person, or download a request form at <https://sos.wyo.gov/Forms/Elections/General/AbsenteeRequestForm.pdf>. Remember to ensure that your completed ballot is returned to your County Clerk's office by 7 p.m. on Election Day.

VOTING ASSISTANCE

Wyoming State law allows ONE person to assist a voter in the following situations: blindness, disability, or inability to read or write. This person cannot be the voter's employer, an agent of the voter's employer, or an agent or officer of the voter's union. Please contact your County Clerk with any questions about polling place accessibility.

BALLOT PROPOSITIONS (CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS, INITIATIVES, AND REFERENDA)

Statewide ballot propositions appear on the General Election Ballot. In order to pass, they must be approved by a majority of those voting in the General Election.

2026 STATEWIDE BALLOT PROPOSITIONS

PROPOSED INITIATIVE PROPOSITION NUMBER ONE

Shall a law be enacted:

Establishing a property tax exemption for qualified homeowners' primary residence in the amount of fifty percent (50%) of the assessed value of the dwelling; AND

Defining "homeowner" and "primary residence"; providing that no more than one exemption shall apply to a single property or be claimed by a single owner per year; requiring a homeowner to be a resident of Wyoming for at least one year and to have occupied the primary residence for at least six months of the previous tax year to qualify; requiring an initial sworn claim to be filed with the county assessor by the fourth Monday in May; providing for continuing the exemption in subsequent years through annually confirming eligibility; providing a penalty for false claims; clarifying that the exemption applies to the residential structure; and specifying applicability?

Estimated Fiscal Impact:

Anticipated Revenue / (decrease)

Fiscal Year 2028 (\$92,614,266)

Fiscal Year 2029 (\$95,855,766)

The above estimate is based on residential property assessed value and property tax data from the Computer Assisted Mass Appraisal (CAMA) system provided by the Department of Revenue in 2023. The future fiscal impact estimates are derived by using the January 2023 Consensus Revenue Estimating Group (CREG) report, estimating annual growth of 3.5% for properties in the future years. This is an estimate of fiscal impact to the State of Wyoming only and does not include an estimate of any impact upon political subdivisions. The proposition references a beginning in 2025, but if passed in 2026 the earliest applicable tax year would be 2027, with impact to the state beginning in 2028. Fiscal impact will apply to each year so long as the exemption is in place. Future impacts depend on unpredictable economic conditions.

VOTER REGISTRATION INFORMATION

IT'S EASY TO REGISTER TO VOTE

You may register *and* vote at your polling place on Election Day.

You may also register to vote in person at the County Clerk's office or by mail not less than (14) days before an election. The voter registration application may be found on the Secretary of State's website at: <https://sos.wyo.gov/Forms/Elections/General/VoterRegistrationForm.pdf>

VOTER REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- ☑ Be a U.S. Citizen, as evidenced by providing proof of U.S. citizenship*
- ☑ Be 18 years of age on or before the day of the next election
- ☑ Be a resident of Wyoming, as evidenced by providing proof of Wyoming residency*
- ☑ Be a bona fide resident of Wyoming for not less than thirty (30) days before the next election
- ☑ Not currently adjudicated mentally incompetent
- ☑ Not been convicted of a felony, or have had voting rights restored
- ☑ Provide your Wyoming Driver's License or Driver's License number and acceptable identification. If you do not have a Wyoming Driver's License number, provide the last four digits of your Social Security Number and another form of acceptable identification*

KEEP YOUR REGISTRATION CURRENT

- If you did not vote in the 2024 General Election you should verify your registration with your County Clerk.
- If you moved to a different Wyoming county, you must now register in that county.
- If you have moved within your county or changed your name since the 2024 Election you must notify your County Clerk.
- If you have questions about the status of your registration, contact your County Clerk.

RESTORATION OF VOTING RIGHTS

What to Bring to Register to Vote

(For all voter registration requirements and documents for registration, see Wyoming Election Procedures, Ch. 2)

Proof of Identity:

Provide any **one** of the following:

- **Valid WY Driver's License / WY ID Card**
- Valid U.S. Passport
- Valid Driver's License / ID Card issued by Federal Government, another State, or U.S. Territory
- Military ID
- Tribal ID
- WY Student Photo ID bearing legal name

OR any **two** or more of the following:

- Certificate of U.S. citizenship or naturalization
- Draft record
- VR Card from out-of-state
- Void or Temporary WY Driver's License
- Social Security Card
- Original or certified copy of birth certificate
- Any other form of ID issued by official agency

Proof of United States Citizenship:

Provide any **one** of the following:

- **Valid WY Driver's License* / WY ID Card***
- Valid Tribal ID*
- Valid, REAL ID Compliant Driver's License / ID Card issued by another state*
- Valid U.S. Passport
- Certificate of U.S. citizenship or naturalization
- Draft record
- U.S. Dept. of State consular report of birth abroad
- Original or certified copy of U.S. birth certificate



Proof of Residency (Must list a WY address):**

Provide any **one** of the following:

- **Valid WY Driver's License / WY ID Card**
- Valid U.S. Passport
- Valid ID Card issued by Federal Government, another State, or U.S. Territory
- Military ID
- Tribal ID
- WY Student Photo ID bearing legal name
- Void or Temporary WY Driver's License

OR one of the following provided it must be current and dated within 90 days from the date of registration:

- Utility bill
- Bank Statement
- Government check, paycheck, or pay stub
- Mortgage statement
- WY student housing verification
- Any government document containing the applicant's name and address

OR one of the following provided it must be dated within 1 year from the date of registration:

- Residential lease
- Contract/intake document from a residential care facility
- WY property tax receipt
- WY hunting or fishing license
- WY vehicle registration
- Communication on letterhead from a social service agency verifying homelessness and attesting to applicant's residence.

*Provided that it does not contain any indication that you are not a U.S. citizen.

** In accordance with W.S. 22-1-102(a)(iv), if you do not have any of these documents you may submit a [signed attestation](#) of your residency.
