VOTING AT THE POLLS WILL BE A LITTLE DIFFERENT.



Here's What to Expect:

- 1. Check In to Vote When you first arrive at your polling location, you will be asked to provide your basic information, such as your name and address, to ensure the poll worker can find your record.
- **2. Show Your ID -** Next, you'll need to provide a poll worker with one of the acceptable forms of identification for voting.
- 3. Get Your Ballot And....





What type of ID do I need to show?

There are many types of IDs for you to use to prove your identity. Any of the following forms of identification will be accepted:

- ★ WY Driver's License or ID Card
- ★ Tribal ID Card
- ★ Valid US Passport
- US Military Card
- DL or ID Card from Another State
- ★ University of Wyoming Student ID
- ★ Wyoming Community College Student ID
- ★ Wyoming Public School Student ID
- ★ Valid Medicare Insurance Card
- ★ Valid Medicaid Insurance Card

What if I don't have my ID with me on Election Day?

If you do not have your ID with you, you can leave to get your ID and return to vote or vote a provisional ballot.

A provisional ballot allows you to vote right then and there, but you will need to bring your acceptable identification with you to your County Clerk's office by the end of the next business day in order for your vote to count.

I don't have any of those IDs. What can I do?

What if I am voting by absentee ballot?

Voters who vote by absentee ballot are not required to provide any additional form of identification.
