Wyoming State Canvassing Board to Meet and Certify General Election Results

CHEYENNE, WY –The Wyoming State Canvassing Board will convene eight days after the General Election on Wednesday, November 14th. The Board will certify the election results and the candidates winning after Wyoming's General Election. Members of the Board are: Governor Matt Mead; Secretary of State Edward Buchanan (chair); State Auditor Cynthia Cloud; and State Treasurer Mark Gordon.

The State Canvassing Board will meet to review and examine precinct-by-precinct results and the winning candidates for statewide races, legislative races, and judicial retention votes. The Secretary of State's Office works closely with Wyoming's 23 County Clerks in overseeing and administering Wyoming's elections.
