



FBI and Secretary of State's Office to Hold Cyber Security Training

CHEYENNE, WY – The FBI Denver Division and the Wyoming Secretary of State's Office have partnered to provide a comprehensive cyber security training for all candidates in the 2018 General Election, elected and appointed officials, as well as campaign staff and party leadership.

This event is being held to promote election integrity and the deterrence of threats against public services and the electoral process. The morning will begin with brief remarks by the FBI Denver Special Agent in Charge Calvin Shivers and Wyoming Secretary of State Edward Buchanan. The event will include briefings from the FBI Cyber and Foreign Counterintelligence Squads, in addition to an interactive training provided by the FBI Denver Chief Security Officer.

Members of the media are invited to attend and obtain footage of the opening remarks. Immediately following, Wyoming Secretary of State Edward Buchanan, FBI Denver Special Agent in Charge Calvin Shivers, and FBI Denver Chief Security Officer Mike Mercer will be available for on-camera interviews.
