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Secretary of State's Office Takes Administrative Action Against Fraudulent Filings by Foreign Adversaries

CHEYENNE, WY – On May 17th, the Secretary of State's Office took administrative action to dissolve three entities flagged as instruments of North Korea by the Federal Bureau of Investigation. Based on the information and an [affidavit](#) provided by the FBI's investigation and further review by the Business Division of the Secretary of State's Office, three entities registered with the State of Wyoming, Culture Box LLC, Next Nets LLC, and Blackish Tech, LLC, had filed false and fraudulent information on documents filed with the Secretary of State's Office, warranting the administrative dissolution process under Wyoming law.

“The communist, authoritarian Kim Jong Un regime has no place in Wyoming,” Secretary of State Chuck Gray said in a statement. “Our office worked quickly and expeditiously to begin the administrative dissolution process. We have proposed several interim topics to the Joint Corporations, Elections, and Political Subdivisions committee of the Wyoming Legislature to take further administrative action against entities on the basis of their being owned or controlled by foreign adversaries.”

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
