Secretary Gray Celebrates Supreme Court Decision Overruling *Chevron* as Huge Win for Wyoming Industries and Elections

CHEYENNE, **WY** – On June 28, the Supreme Court of the United States issued a decision overruling the *Chevron* doctrine, which gave judicial deference to federal agencies in their interpretation of federal law. The ruling has widespread implications in curtailing the power of the federal administrative state.

Speaking to some of its impacts on Wyoming's core industries and the ability of states to conduct elections, Secretary of State Chuck Gray said, "Today's ruling is a huge win for the people of Wyoming. The Supreme Court's decision to overturn *Chevron* is a major blow to the Biden Administration's radical attempts to destroy Wyoming's core industries through its unprecedented federal overreach. As a member of the State Board of Land Commissioners, I have pushed back against the Biden Administration's massive federal overreach in taking on its disastrous Resource Management Plan in Southwest Wyoming."

"As Wyoming's Chief Election Official, I also joined other states in filing an <u>Amicus Curiae</u> <u>Brief</u> before the Supreme Court of the United States against the Biden Administration's Executive Order No. 14019, which is unconstitutional and is itself beyond the bounds of the powers Congress has delegated to the federal executive branch. Biden is attempting to allow illegal aliens to vote with this illegal, unconstitutional executive order. We are fighting these outrageously wrong, radical left-wing actions, and today's decision will help us in doing that. I am heartened by the Court's ruling, and will continue to fight back against the Biden Administration's unprecedented federal overreach."
