## **Secretary Gray Statement Applauding Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals' Decision as Huge Win for Election Integrity**

**CHEYENNE, WY** – In response to the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals' decision that Mississippi's law allowing mail-in ballots to be received after the day of the election is unlawful, Wyoming Secretary of State Chuck Gray released the following statement applauding the ruling as a huge win for election integrity:

*"I applaud the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals for their common-sense decision. Wyoming State law makes clear that ballots must be received by Election Day. But other states have allowed ballots after Election Day, and have had many problems. The Fifth Circuit's decision is a huge, important win for election integrity."*
