2024 General Election Morning Informational and Turnout Update

CHEYENNE, WY – The 2024 General Election is today. Polls for the General Election close at 7:00 p.m. Any eligible elector present and waiting to vote at the polls at 7:00 p.m. shall be allowed to vote. Absentee ballots must be returned to the county clerk no later than 7:00 p.m. today, November 5th, to be counted. As of this morning, before the polls opened, voter turnout was 115,785, or about 45% of the total number of registered voters at that time.

"Participating in the electoral process is a crucial part of our republic," Secretary of State Chuck Gray stated. "I encourage every eligible voter who has not yet voted to get out and vote."
