## 2024 General Election Afternoon Update

CHEYENNE, WY – As Election Day continues, voter turnout remains high across Wyoming. Polls for the General Election close at 7:00 p.m. Any eligible elector present and waiting to vote at the polls at 7:00 p.m. shall be allowed to vote. **Absentee ballots must be returned to the county clerk no later than 7:00 p.m. today, November 5<sup>th</sup>, to be counted.** As of 2:30 p.m., 116,405 absentee ballots, which is over 97% of absentee ballots that were requested, had been returned to county clerks.

"Voter turnout remains strong across the Cowboy State as Wyomingites exercise their right to vote in all 23 counties," Secretary of State Chuck Gray stated. "In administering this election, our office has been in regular communication with county clerks and all Wyomingites for Election Day inquiries and needs. We are looking forward to releasing unofficial results later tonight."
