Secretary Gray Notifies Wyoming Business Owners of Last-Minute Appeals Court Decision on CTA; Requests Wyoming AG to Seek to Block Enforcement of CTA in Wyoming

CHEYENNE, WY – In response to the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals' issuance of a stay on a nationwide injunction enjoining the United States Government from enforcing the Corporate Transparency Act (CTA) and its Implementing Regulations, Secretary of State Chuck Gray issued a letter to Wyoming Attorney General Bridget Hill requesting she take immediate action on behalf of the State of Wyoming to enjoin the enforcement of the CTA in Wyoming.

"The CTA is an unconstitutional intrusion hurting Wyoming small business owners. We have been closely monitoring the legal challenges to it. The latest news that the CTA will again be in effect is deeply troubling. In response, I have asked the Wyoming Attorney General to seek to stop the CTA with an injunction."
