Secretary Gray Celebrates Wyoming House Passage of Fourth Part of Election Integrity Agenda with Bill to Ban Ballot Harvesting

CHEYENNE, WY – On February 5th, the Wyoming House of Representatives passed House Bill 238 to ban ballot harvesting in Wyoming, another key plank of Wyoming Secretary of State Chuck Gray's <u>election integrity reform agenda</u> announced earlier this year. House Bill 238, which is sponsored by Representative Steve Johnson, passed the House on Third reading 52-8.

"I applaud the House's passage of House Bill 238," Secretary Gray said in a statement. "Banning ballot harvesting in Wyoming is our fourth priority of our election integrity reform agenda. I want to commend the House for passing it.
