Secretary Gray Celebrates Wyoming House Passage of Sixth Part of Election Integrity Agenda with Bill to Ban Zuck Bucks

CHEYENNE, WY – On February 11th, the Wyoming House of Representatives passed House Bill 228, “Prohibition on private funds for conducting elections.” This was the sixth plank of Wyoming Secretary of State Chuck Gray’s [election integrity reform agenda](#) announced earlier this year. House Bill 228 passed the House on Third reading 57-4.

“I applaud the House’s passage of House Bill 228, which will ban Zuck Bucks in Wyoming,” Secretary Gray said in a statement. “Banning private funding of election administration has been a huge priority for our administration, and I have been vocal in warning about the real dangers of Zuck Bucks and partisan organizations attempting to fund election administration in every state. As I have previously warned, these grants are also deeply disturbing given the capacity for them to expose states like Wyoming to funding streams linked to potentially foreign actors. This is the sixth part of our conservative election integrity reform agenda. I want to commend the House for passing it. As we continue with the 2025 Legislative Session, I look forward to continuing to work with the Wyoming Legislature to achieve meaningful, conservative election integrity reform.”
