Secretary Gray Expresses Strong Disagreement with Federal Court Injunctions of President Trump's Executive Orders

Requiring proof of citizenship for registering to vote is common sense and totally consistent with the United States Constitution and statute. And President Trump's Executive Order stopping federal funds from going to illegal sanctuary cities is totally consistent with the United States Constitution and statute. The fact that liberal judicial activists continue to block these measures is insanity."
