Secretary Gray Signs Agreement with Trump Administration to Enhance Voter List Maintenance

CHEYENNE, WY –Secretary of State Chuck Gray has signed a Memorandum of Agreement between the Wyoming Secretary of State's Office and the Department of Homeland Security, U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services to allow for increased voter list maintenance services through the Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) Program. Increased voter list maintenance procedures, including access to the SAVE System, were a key priority of Secretary Gray's [conservative Election Integrity Agenda](#) announced ahead of the 2025 Legislative Session.

“Enhanced voter list maintenance procedures are crucial to election integrity by ensuring only eligible voters appear on Wyoming's voter rolls. I'm very proud to have entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Trump Administration to ensure increased voter list maintenance by entering Wyoming in the SAVE database. This will help to ensure that only citizens are on the voter registration list. I'm grateful to President Trump and the Trump administration's work to prioritize voter list maintenance, and am looking forward to continuing to work with the Trump administration in carrying out enhanced voter list maintenance through the SAVE Database.”
