## **Secretary Gray Exercises Oversight over SLIB Affordable Housing Project in Teton County**

**CHEYENNE, WY** – On September 23rd, Wyoming Secretary of State Chuck Gray sent a letter to the Office of State Lands and Investments inquiring about a \$1.25 Million State Loan and Investment Board grant for affordable housing made to the Town of Jackson for the “Flat Creek Apartments Project” in December of 2023. As a member of the State Loan and Investment Board, Secretary Gray voted against the grant.

“Recently, I have received a considerable amount of concern from constituents that the rental units authorized by the grant are not, in fact, serving the individuals in need of affordable housing,” Secretary Gray said. “While I did not vote for the project, it is important that we have accountability and oversight over these grants to ensure they are being utilized for their stated purpose. As a member of the State Loan and Investment Board, I will continue to ensure Wyoming’s investments are being made for their stated purpose.”
