Secretary Gray Joins Lieutenant Governors and Secretaries of State Supporting Trump Administration, Calling on U.S. Senate Democrats to Avoid Government Shutdown

CHEYENNE, WY – On September 29th, Wyoming Secretary of State Chuck Gray, in his capacity as the Lieutenant Governor and Secretary of State of Wyoming, sent a letter with other respective lieutenant governors and secretaries of state around the country, in total support of the Trump Administration, and calling on the United States Senate to immediately pass a clean short-term funding extension to prevent a government shutdown.
