Dear Chairman Allen and Members of the Commission:

I write today in regards to the Supreme Court of the United States' ruling in *Louisiana v. Callais, et al*, striking down a Louisiana congressional map that was the product of unconstitutional racial gerrymandering, and the effects it has in Wyoming. With the Supreme Court's ruling, it is clear that drawing districts based on race is squarely unconstitutional, and a blatant violation of the Fourteenth Amendment.

As the Chief Election official for the State of Wyoming, I bring this to your attention because of the impacts that *Callais* has on Wyoming. Given the Fremont County Commission is the only county commission which is drawn into districts with consideration of race, I believe the Commission's existing electoral boundaries are in violation of the *Callais* decision, and the United States Constitution.

Fremont County's previous at-large selection, mirroring the practice around the State of Wyoming, was clearly in line with the United States Constitution, and Wyoming law. I believe the Commission should take immediate action in order to elect commissioners in compliance with both Wyoming State law, as well as the United States Constitution, in light of the ruling of *Callais*.
