Dear Governor Gordon:

I write today in regards to the Supreme Court of the United States' ruling in *Louisiana v. Callais, et al*, striking down a Louisiana congressional map that was the product of unconstitutional racial gerrymandering, and the effects it has on Wyoming. With the Supreme Court's ruling, it is clear that drawing districts based on race is a blatant violation of the United States Constitution.

As the Chief Election official for the State of Wyoming, I bring this to your attention because of Wyoming's duty to comply with *Callais*. In this letter, I wish to bring to your attention Wyoming's 2022 Legislative redistricting legislation, in which the Legislature gave consideration to race in drawing House District 33 in Fremont County. I believe House District 33's boundaries need to be examined to ensure compliance with *Callais*.

The Joint Corporations Committee is meeting next week, and I expect this to be discussed. However, I believe you, as Governors in other states have done, need to provide a path of action to examine legislative districts to ensure our compliance with the United States Constitution in light of *Callais*.
