Secretary Gray Announces Comprehensive Business Fraud Reporting Webpage, Further Legislative Reform to Take on Fraud

CHEYENNE, WY – On February 3, 2026, Wyoming Secretary of State Chuck Gray announced the launch of a [comprehensive webpage](#) dedicated to reporting business filing fraud in accordance with existing Wyoming law. Also, ahead of the 2026 Legislative Session, he announced a legislative priority to amend Wyoming law to allow the Wyoming Secretary of State's Office to administratively dissolve entities which have been found criminally or civilly liable for committing fraud on another person or entity, in partnership with Representative Ann Lucas.

“From day one, our administration has prioritized taking administrative action to dissolve fraudulent business entities in accordance with Wyoming law. As part of our effort to streamline the fraudulent filing reporting process, I am excited to launch our Business Filing Fraud Reporting webpage, which is a one-stop shop for citizens to report false or fraudulent filings so our office can take action in accordance with Wyoming law. I am also excited to announce our collaboration with Representative Lucas, to increase our office’s authority to dissolve entities which have committed fraud on another individual.”
