Secretary Gray Lambasts Killing of Election Integrity Bills

CHEYENNE, WY – In response to the Wyoming Legislature's failure to achieve two thirds majority vote to introduce a number of election integrity bills proposed by Wyoming Secretary of State Chuck Gray during the 2025 Interim Session and sponsored by the Joint Corporations Committee of the Wyoming Legislature, Secretary Gray made the following statement:

"I am extremely disappointed that a small minority of Democrats and insiders have chosen to kill common-sense, conservative election integrity reforms that the people of Wyoming want. Requiring pen and paper ballots, banning ballot harvesting and banning ballot drop boxes, and strengthening Wyoming's Voter ID statute are key to implementing President Trump's Election integrity work and specifically President Trump's election integrity Executive Order Preserving and Protecting the Integrity of American Elections.
