## **Secretary Gray Applauds U.S. House Passage of Election Integrity Legislation**

**CHEYENNE, WY** – In response to the United States House of Representatives’ passage of the Safeguard American Voter Eligibility (SAVE) America Act on February 11, Secretary of State Chuck Gray made the following statement:

“I applaud the United States House of Representatives’ passage of the SAVE America Act. I have and continue to support this baseline, common-sense election integrity legislation, which would require proof of United States Citizenship and Voter ID in federal elections across the country. In Wyoming, we have adopted these important election integrity measures, and it is so important that we have a uniform standard across the country to ensure that only United States citizens are voting in American elections. I was proud to testify in support of both the SAVE America Act and the MEGA Act in Congress this week. I thank President Trump for his leadership and for his work to advance the SAVE America Act. I also thank Congresswoman Harriet Hageman for her vote in support of the SAVE America Act, and I hope that the United States Senate passes this key reform to enhance and secure the integrity of American elections.”
