Secretary Gray Applauds Wyoming Supreme Court's Decision Affirming Dismissal of Lawsuit to Remove Secretary Gray from Office

CHEYENNE, WY – On February 13, 2026, the Wyoming Supreme Court affirmed the dismissal of a lawsuit filed by Tim Newcomb which sought to remove Secretary Gray from office under the Fourteenth Amendment (*Tim Newcomb v. Chuck Gray*).

In a statement applauding the Wyoming Supreme Court's decision affirming the dismissal, Secretary Gray said, “The unhinged Left’s attempts to remove me from office because of my support for President Trump shows how far the radical Left is willing to go to get its way. There is a reason why the radical Left is going after me in the same way that they’ve attacked President Trump—because we’re both advancing conservative, MAGA principles that the people of Wyoming and the entire United States want. I’m glad that the rule of law continues to win out in these disturbing escalating moves by the radical Left to remove me from office because of my support for President Trump. This case embodies everything that is wrong with the radical Left today. The weaponization of the Fourteenth Amendment by the radical Left to try and remove conservatives from office undermines everything we stand for. I am glad that the Wyoming Supreme Court affirmed the dismissal of this outrageously wrong lawsuit.”
