## **Citing Wyoming's work on Proof of Citizenship for Registering to vote and Voter ID, Secretary Gray Sends Letter to United States Senate Majority Leader Thune Urging Passage of SAVE America Act**

**CHEYENNE, WY** – On March 17th, Wyoming Secretary of State Chuck Gray sent a letter expressing his support of the Safeguarding American Voter Eligibility (SAVE) America Act, urging United States Senate Majority Leader John Thune to enforce the talking filibuster to ensure its passage. In it, Secretary Gray discussed his work in successfully passing voter ID and proof of citizenship for registering to vote in Wyoming, key planks in the SAVE America Act.

In a statement, Secretary Gray said, “The SAVE America Act is so important to providing common-sense, baseline protections in our elections, including documentary proof of United States citizenship, Voter ID, and other key planks of President Trump’s election integrity work. In Wyoming, we have successfully passed and defended our landmark proof of citizenship requirement, which is crucial to ensuring only United States citizens are voting in our elections, as well as passing voter ID. Wyoming has shown that these common-sense measures that have 90% support from Americans are easy to implement and that they work. It is so important that we now pass the SAVE America Act, to require documentary proof of U.S. citizenship and Voter ID, so that these protections can be in place across the United States. The SAVE America Act has my full and complete support, and the United States Senate needs to pass the bill and get it done.”
