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## **Secretary of State's Office Seeks Public Comment on Proposed Amendments to Chapter 2 of its Election Procedures in Accordance with 2026 Senate Enrolled Act No. 5**

**CHEYENNE, WY** – On March 25, 2026, in accordance with 2026 Senate Enrolled Act No. 5, the Office of the Secretary of State filed its Notice of Intent to amend Chapter 2 of its Election Procedures with the Wyoming Administrative Rules System to amend Chapter 2, Section 8, concerning documents allowed as acceptable documentation for durational residency upon a challenge, in conformance with 2026 Senate Enrolled Act No. 5's amendments to W.S. 22-1-102(a)(xxvi), requiring that a qualified elector be a bona fide resident of the State of Wyoming for not less than thirty (30) days before the date of the next election.
