## **Secretary Gray Continues Push for SAVE America Act, Leads Secretary of State Joint Letter of Support**

**CHEYENNE, WY** – Wyoming Secretary of State Chuck Gray sent a joint letter of Secretaries of State reiterating support of the Safeguarding American Voter Eligibility (SAVE) America Act, and urging United States Senate Majority Leader John Thune to enforce the talking filibuster to ensure its passage. Secretary Gray was joined by Indiana Secretary of State Diego Morales.

“As the chief election officials of our respective states, we write today in complete and total support of the Safeguard American Voter Eligibility (SAVE) America Act,” Gray and Morales wrote. “Both of our states have passed and implemented the reforms in the SAVE America Act, including Voter ID and forms of DPOC. In fact, Wyoming became the first state in the nation to pass an ironclad proof of citizenship requirement for all races in 2025. Election integrity and security is crucial to keeping our republic. This is why the protections offered by the SAVE Act are so important. In both Wyoming, and Indiana, we have proven these common-sense election reforms work, and must be successfully implemented to safeguard our elections, and our way of life. Therefore, we urge you to use the Senate’s existing rules, to enforce a talking filibuster for the SAVE America Act, and force the radical democrats to explain why they would oppose these common-sense election integrity reforms. The American people demand nothing less.
