## **Secretary of State Continues Enhanced Voter List Maintenance Program, Sends Counties Additional Records Matching Individuals who have Obtained Driver's Licenses in other States**

**CHEYENNE, WY** – On March 31, Wyoming Secretary of State Chuck Gray sent an additional 514 records matching individuals who obtained driver's licenses in another state to county clerks around Wyoming for review and potential removal from Wyoming's Statewide Voter Registry System in accordance with Wyoming law. This is in addition to over 3,300 voter records the office previously sent to Wyoming's 23 counties, and part of continual efforts to enhance voter list maintenance procedures. [House Enrolled Act 62](#) from the 2025 Legislative Session, which comprised a key plank of Secretary Gray's [2025 Election Integrity Reform Agenda](#), provides authority to the Secretary of State's Office to obtain information that the Wyoming Department of Transportation has received from other states when an individual on the voter registration list has obtained a driver's license from another state, indicating they may have moved out of the State of Wyoming.

In a statement, Secretary Gray said, "Voter list maintenance continues to be a key priority of my administration. As Wyoming's chief election official, we're working to ensure that Wyoming's voter rolls are the cleanest in the nation. I'm proud of our work to continue to implement these common-sense measures to Wyoming's voter list maintenance procedures. Our office's diligence in matching these batches of records of those who have requested licenses in other states will ensure that Wyoming's voter rolls are comprised only of residents of Wyoming. Only Wyoming residents should be voting in Wyoming elections-period."
