## Secretary Gray Writes Letters to Fremont County Commissioners and Governor Mark Gordon Regarding Supreme Court of the United States' *Callais* Decision

CHEYENNE, WY – Wyoming Secretary of State Chuck Gray recently sent letters to the Fremont County Commission and Governor Mark Gordon on compliance with the United States Supreme Court's ruling in *Louisiana v. Callais*, which struck down a Louisiana Congressional map that was the product of unconstitutional racial gerrymandering.

In a statement, Secretary Gray stated, "The Supreme Court's common-sense ruling is clear. With the Supreme Court's important ruling, it is clear that drawing districts based on race is a blatant violation of the United States Constitution. In light of the *Callais* decision, action must be taken to END race-based districting to comply with the Constitution."
