Secretary Gray Celebrates Legislative Committee Approving Election Integrity Proposals for 2026 Interim Session

CHEYENNE, WY – On May 22nd, Wyoming Secretary of State Chuck Gray presented a number of legislative proposals to the Joint Corporations Committee of the Wyoming Legislature that would strengthen the integrity and security of Wyoming elections, including bill proposals to require pen and paper ballots, ban ballot drop boxes, ban ballot harvesting, require hand counting of ballots, strengthen Wyoming's Voter ID statute, and strengthen political party poll watching and representation. These proposals were approved as bill drafts to be considered by the committee during the 2026 Interim Session.

“It is great news that the committee has chosen to adopt our office's election integrity legislative proposals and approve them for the 2026 Interim. I have repeatedly worked to pass these bills in previous sessions. These are basic election integrity reforms that are supported by the people of Wyoming. We will continue to work to enhance and improve the integrity, security, and confidence of Wyoming elections.”
