## **Secretary Gray Files Motion to Dismiss Lawsuit Challenging Wyoming's Primary System**

**CHEYENNE, WY** – On May 26th, Wyoming Secretary of State Chuck Gray, through the Wyoming Attorney General's Office, filed a motion to dismiss a new lawsuit challenging Wyoming's closed primary system, filed by Jimmy Skovgard.

In a statement, Secretary Gray said "Wyoming's primary system is vital to the integrity of Wyoming's elections. Primary systems like Wyoming's withstand scrutiny around the country as a basic method of choosing candidates for the general election. These baseless lawsuits show how far the radical left will go to dismantle the core systems of our republic. I take these attacks on our primary system very seriously, and we have defended lawsuit after lawsuit to ensure the integrity of our primaries. We have prepared a strong motion to dismiss this case. I am confident that this meritless lawsuit will be dismissed."
