Secretary Gray Makes Statement Regarding His Work to Stop Wind Leases after Today's State Board of Land Commissioners Meeting

CHEYENNE, WY – On June 8, 2026, Wyoming Secretary of State Chuck Gray, as a member of the State Board of Land Commissioners, made a motion to continue cancellation of wind leases issued to Pronghorn H2, LLC in Converse County and Sidewinder H2, LLC in Niobrara County. Secretary Gray's motion failed on a vote of 2-3.

In a statement, Secretary Gray said, "These woke wind projects should be cancelled, and it's disappointing that we weren't able to stop these woke wind projects today. It has become very apparent that the insiders' plan all along has been to dither and delay the process of cancelling these woke wind leases. As a member of the board, I have been against these wind leases from the very beginning. The way these wind leases continue to be propped up, despite our earlier motions to rescind, are highly unusual and deeply disturbing. I continue to remain concerned by these wind leases, and will continue to work to stop these woke wind leases."
