## **Wyoming Secretary of State Defends Wyoming's Primary System**

**CHEYENNE, WY** – On June 10th, the Wyoming Supreme Court heard oral arguments in *Malcom et al v. Chuck Gray*, on appeal from Wyoming District Court Judge Nathaniel Hibben's November 7, 2025 decision granting summary judgment in favor of Wyoming Secretary of State Chuck Gray, and upholding Wyoming's ban on crossover voting.

"I have defended and will continue to defend Wyoming's primary system and our ban on crossover tactics amid these radical Left attacks in court," Secretary Gray said in a statement. "Following the decision of Wyoming District Court Judge Nathaniel Hibben upholding Wyoming's ban on crossover tactics, I am confident that these election integrity laws will be upheld. Upholding the integrity of the primary system by stopping crossover practices strengthens Wyoming's primary system and has been a key part of our administration's election integrity agenda, and is squarely constitutional. Many states have these crossover bans, and they are squarely constitutional and uphold the integrity of the primary system. I will continue to defend our primary system."
