## **Secretary of State's Statement on Bill to End Crossover Voting Becoming Law**

**Cheyenne, WY** – On March 2nd, House Enrolled Act 70, originally House Bill 103 “Political party affiliation declaration and changes,” became law. The bill received overwhelming support by the Wyoming Legislature, having attained an affirmative vote of 51-9 on third reading in the Wyoming House of Representatives and a vote of 19-11 on third reading in the Wyoming Senate. It was allowed to become law by the Governor.

“Today marks a pivotal moment for election integrity in Wyoming,” Secretary of State Chuck Gray said. “This bill means a great deal to the people of Wyoming. House Enrolled Act 70 will stop the recurrent problem of crossover voting, a process which has undermined the sanctity of Wyoming’s primary process. Ending crossover voting to protect the integrity of the election process has been our office’s number one priority this Session and we worked diligently on its passage. I couldn’t be more excited by its becoming law today and will ensure its proper implementation.”
